Over the years, the show has continued to build and adapt. Held for a number of years at the Yakima SunDome, the bridal show moved back to the Yakima Convention Center in 2012. Organizers received rave reviews about the remodeled show’s improved atmosphere and new runway show.

The show’s bridal guide, *Bliss*, is loaded with ideas and resources designed especially for couples planning a Central Washington wedding. 

# MAKE IT LEGAL

## *Getting your marriage license*

**OBTAINING A MARRIAGE LICENSE** is likely one of the simplest tasks you'll cross off your wedding to-do list.

In Washington, there's a three-day waiting period after your application is filed with the county auditor's office until your marriage license is valid, so you'll need to apply at least three days prior to exchanging vows. A marriage license is valid for 60 days anywhere in the state.

Expect to pay a non-refundable fee (\$64 in Yakima County, cash only; the fee is \$35 in Kittitas County, payable by cash, check or money order). A keepsake certificate or certified copies (needed for a name change) carry an additional fee.

Blood tests are not required. Both parties must be at least 18 years old (17 under some circumstances) and visit the courthouse together to submit the application.

You'll need to bring photo ID and your Social Security numbers, if applicable, as well as the names of your parents and their birth state or country.

No witnesses are needed to obtain a marriage license, but state law requires at least two witnesses be present at the ceremony. Only a judge or licensed or ordained minister can perform the ceremony.

## 10-12 months

- Announce your engagement!
- Have your engagement party if you choose to do so.

- Select and reserve your ceremony site.
- Select and reserve your reception site.
- Select and reserve your officiant.
- Select your wedding party and other attendants, including ushers and candle lighters.
- Order passports, visas or birth certificate if required for your honeymoon.
- Protect your ring with insurance.

## 8-9 months

- Submit your engagement announcement to the newspaper.
- Order save-the-date cards and mail them out.
- Select and order your bridal gown.
- Select your wedding colors, style and theme.
- Select and book your music for the ceremony.
- Select and book your music for the reception.
- Select and book your photographer.
- Take engagement photos.

## 6-7 months

- Select and book your florist.
- Select and book your caterer.
- Select and book your videographer.
- Make a tasting appointment with your caterer for menu options.
- Select attendant's attire and order.
- Reserve all rental items, including tables, chairs, tents, china and linens.

## 4-5 months

- Finalize your guest list.
- Select and order stationary, including invitations, RSVPs, programs, thank-you notes and table cards.
- Select and book your bakery and choose your cake design.
- Purchase wedding day accessories, including shoes, veil, lingerie and jewelry.
- Select and order mother-of-the-bride dress and accessories.
- Check delivery dates for all attire and schedule fittings.
- Arrange accommodations for out-of-town guests.
- Reserve wedding night bridal suite.
- Reserve wedding day transportation.
- Plan honeymoon and book.
- Register for gifts.
- Set the date, time and location for your rehearsal dinner.
- Check blood test and marriage license requirements.

## 2-3 months

- Select and order guest favors.
- Select and order ceremony and reception décor.
- Purchase gifts for your wedding attendants.
- Purchase wedding rings and have them engraved.
